- Serious major violations
- Situations involving student safety
- Alcohol
- Illegal substances/activities



Serious violations, regardless of point total, may result in the student being recommended for expulsion as detailed in student handbook.

1-5 Points	Parent Contact, Possible Parent Conference

6-10 Points	Required Parent Conference

16-20 Points	Required Parent Conference, Administrative Review, Disciplinary Probation; Restriction of Privileges
21-25 Points	Required Parent Conference, Administrative Review, Administrative
	Probation, Conditional Enrollment in School, Loss of Participation in all activities

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW BOARD

Administrator, dean of students, student's counselor, any other personnel deemed appropriate.

Addresses needs of repeat violators.

Reviews current interventions and determines future needs and goals for the student.

Students Who Reach 30 Points

- 1) Suspended for 10 Days
- 2) During 10 Day Period a decision will be made to begin:
- ***** Enrollment in District 230 Alternative Education Program
- ***** Recommendation to School Board for Expulsion Hearing
- ✗ If 16 years of age or older, he/she can voluntarily withdraw from District 230.
- If student chooses to withdraw, student can return the following semester.
- ✗ If student returns same school year, the student will return with 25 points.
- Upon return, students will have the ability to reduce points from total with appropriate behavior. 4 points will be deducted for each month that passes without a referral to the Dean's Office.
