

Governance

What to Do First

Guiding Questions and Ideas

Who will create the return to the school Committee as the point of contact?
What visions are in line with local values and community needs?
Define and assign roles and responsibilities for committee members
Institute regular virtual meeting schedule.
How will a determination be made on what to assess, where additional capacity and support may be needed?

What to do before School Starts

Guiding Questions and Ideas

Establish/Re-establish a district level Pandemic Response Committee Define/Redefine the core structure of the Pandemic Response Committee What is the timeline to amend existing Pandemic Response Plans and Emergence Recovery Plans based on lessons learned from the outbreak?

What scenario plans need to be developed for: When school begins on time and remains open? When schools begin on time and closes due to a 2nd wave of COVID 19? If the school opening is delayed? When will key stakeholders be met with to understand their expectations?

Improve communication protocols. Release the district return to plans to the community.

Build a Return to Instruction working group. Create goals to ensure every student is successfully academic. socially, and emotionally. Develop a plan for assessing students progress Inventory interventions, programs, and services. Who are the most vulnerable students?Connect with State Board of Education and stay current of mandates on: testing, grading, report cards, and promotion. How can teachers engage with intentional curriculum planning? Secure resources and restorative supports. When and what can professional learning offering for teachers occur?

Review data from schools.

Create school leader checkpoints around the pacing of the curriculum, monitoring student progress, and monitoring at risk-students.

Develop a targeted intervention plan.

Set a goal of ensuring that all academic and social-emotional interventions are assessed.

Assess and update on student enrollment and attendance policies.

Communicate student and attendance policy changes.

Work with the department of education's recommendations and resources.

How do we recruit, interview, and hire staff remotely?

What to do before School Starts

Guiding Questions and Ideas

What type of staffing guidance is needed in regards to hiring additional specialists, social workers, or guidance counselors?

Consult legal counsel over current technology vendor contracts.

What type of budgeting exercises can help us plan for enrollment patterns, new staffing needs, and resources?

Review, amend, or create policies for extracurriculars and athletics in regards to spectators, contact sports, and equipment sterilization based on CDC guidance.

Meet with transportation to implement bussing plans that meet the social distancing requirements, if needed, along with the cleaning and disinfection protocols.

Is a vendo needed to assist in processing the returning of devices?

How to develop a device triage area?

Develop a check in process to inventory district owned technology.

Does a device processing area need to be established?

Place orders for replacement devices.

Share return to school technology plan with key stakeholders and revise if needed.

Centralize online resources that were created during the remote learning period.
